The 2018-2019 volleyball season had several events that took place

1. 2019 Western Canada Summer Games

Coach Development:

For WCSG, our head coaches must be fully certified Advanced Coach level, with Assistant Coaches having their Development Coach level for both beach and indoor teams. We have recruited six new coaches that will be participating in an upcoming coach development workshop, going on to be evaluated. Currently working on a date that accommodates all coaches and facilitator.

We have had five coaches participate in workshops and courses throughout the year, moving forward with their certification at the development and advanced levels. These courses include Nutrition, Making Head Way, and Making Ethical Decisions.

We had two participants attend the Coach Evaluator training in Edmonton, AB to gain Volleyball Coach Evaluators in the North. We should see them full Evaluators within the next season.
